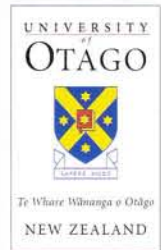


THE UNIVERSITY OF OTAGO FOUNDATION YEAR



Foundation Year prepares students for degrees in Business, Health Sciences, Humanities and Science (streams may include Arts, Applied Science, Commerce/Business, Design, Life Science, Health Sciences and Physical Education).

We are located in a modern and comfortable building on campus at the University of Otago, New Zealand's first university and the top ranked university for research quality.*

The university has 20,000 students, 2,500 international students from 80 countries and offers courses at undergraduate and postgraduate level in Humanities, Health Sciences, Science and Business.

SPECIAL FEATURES

Students are taught in lecture theatres and laboratories on campus ensuring that they feel confident and familiar with the university environment

Students develop communication and problem solving skills and gain the knowledge they require for undergraduate study

Small class sizes: 16 students, 20 – 24 hours per week of classes plus 20 hours of further study

Free one-on-one consultation times where teachers help students learn new information and study skills

Guaranteed places are offered in first year undergraduate courses if international students meet requirements

Students come from over 25 countries, including New Zealand

Online visa service that can renew student visas or change a visitor visa to a student visa

Student ID card – giving access to University of Otago resources including information services, 24 hour computer suites, student health, clubs and societies, cafes and discounts on shopping, entertainment and travel

Professional student support officers provide assistance with visa issues and any questions

Accommodation options include homestay, university owned flats or private flats
